

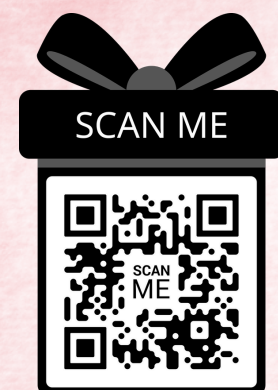
Holly Jolly Christmas
